

Yardage Estimate*

Quilt Size: 50" x 58"


Background	2 yards
Letters	1 1/4 yards
Sashing	1 yard
Outer Border	3/4 yard
Binding	1/2 yard

*42" fabric width


Note: To make a larger quilt (lap size) arrange the quilt six blocks across by seven down and add the number blocks or a name and a date in the bottom two rows. Get an extra 1/2 yard each of the background, letters, and border fabrics and an extra yard of sashing.

General Directions:

1. All measurements include 1/4" seams. Sewing a scant 1/4" will allow for the thickness of the seam when pressing and lead to a more accurate block size.
2. The letter and number blocks measure 5" square when finished. Framed blocks finish 7" square.

For the frame cut four  1 1/2" x 5 1/2" background and cut four  1 1/2" x 1 1/2" corner squares

3. Sewn-off corners (sometimes called snowball corners) are used in all of the blocks. Mark a line from corner to corner on the "snowball" square. Position in the appropriate corner and sew just on the inside of the marked line. This is like the scant 1/4" seam and allows for the thickness of the fabric. Press the "snowball" toward the corner and trim off the bottom two thicknesses leaving the 1/4" seam.
